

BOARD MEMBER AUTHORITY

- A. Schools are open for visitation any time, with the visitors identifying themselves to the building administrators.
- B. When a board member receives a complaint concerning the operation of CRCS, or of a personal nature, the board member will ask the complainant to first contact the person or persons directly involved. If the problem is not resolved, they should contact the Principal. In the event the complaint is not resolved through the informal procedure, the constituent may take the complaint to the board via the agenda for final disposition.
- C. Board members shall have authority only when acting as a body and have no authority except at board meetings or when discharging a specific assignment made by a majority vote of the board.
