

TRANSPORTATION SERVICES MANAGEMENT

The Executive Director with the approval of the Board and in accordance with the State Law will provide the following transportation services:

CRCS will provide transportation for students to and from the school that is within our catchment area. The bussing contractor has determined a route that will be cost effective and within the budget limitations set by the EPS for transportation funding. In order to accomplish this, they have determined that there will need to be at least two routes roughly equidistant from the school and each other and near the outskirts of the catchment area. There will tentatively be one route starting at the information parking lot in Skowhegan and one starting at the Labonville Store parking lot on the outskirts of Madison. Parents will need to arrange for their child's transportation to the closest stop unless they live along the direct route, in which case they may be transported directly from their residence. Other stops will be made at the intersection of roads along the direct routes. Students from outside the catchment area will have to be transported to one of the designated stops.

Bus routes will be reviewed annually. Appeals for additional stops must be made in writing to the Executive Director, and if so requested by the parent, the decision of the Executive Director may be reviewed by the Board at their discretion.

Transportation shall be accomplished in the most economical manner that is consistent with the welfare and safety of the students.
