

FIRST AID AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE

The Executive Director will establish and implement procedures for handling accidents and injuries, which will make clear the responsibilities of various school personnel. They will be based upon recommendations in the SCHOOL HEALTH MANUAL. The Executive Director will maintain a system for accident reporting and for maintaining emergency health and contact information on each student. The Executive Director will also designate appropriate staff members to be responsible for administering first aid and will provide these individuals with appropriate training

“First aid is defined as immediate and temporary treatment and care in the event of an accident or injury, before a physician’s care can be obtained. Because of the presence of children and staff engaged in a variety of activities together, accidents and injuries at school are expected.”
